

### Car Washes Planning & How-To Guide

#### Goal:

- -To build sales and provide a fun atmosphere while people are waiting for their cars to be washed.
- -Take the opportunity to get involved with local charities to raise funds and awareness for them.

#### **How To Execute A Great Car Wash:**

- Get a charity involved this is a great way to raise money and awareness of a charity organization.
- Car Washes should take place the same days each week to increase awareness.
  - Example: Guests will start telling their friends "You should get your car washed every second Saturday afternoon at Twin Peaks! They have cold beer while you wait!"
- This is a great way to build business during slower hours host car washes from 4-7pm early in week and 11am-3pm on Saturdays and Sundays.
  - o Note: Be mindful of big sporting events when scheduling car washes.
- Once you decide on an optimal day and time for your store, order banners and door clings from ColorMark well in advance to start advertising.
- Be sure to post on social media frequently and create an event on Facebook page ahead of the kickoff.
- Be sure you have all the necessities from start to finish:
  - Hose + spray nozzle
  - Buckets
  - Soap
  - o Sponges
  - Drying towels
  - Signs
    - Create signs for TPGs to hold during the wash to draw attention signs should be bright and easy to read.
  - Canopy tents with banners (draws attention)
- Image standards should be kept up treat this as a standard costume party:
  - o NO one-pieces or heels.
  - o Twin Peaks Girls need to be in full bikini and following the guidelines listed on next page.
